- 1. Provide GWA members access to comments through a shared FTP location to ensure each GSA can access and review GSP comments.
- 2. Appoint a temporary, ad hoc committee to review and summarize the comments and provide recommendations regarding responses and potential changes to the GSP.
- 3. Adopt a protocol that requires each GSA forward any GSP comments it receives to the consultant within 3 business days of receipt.
